PROJECT SUMMARY & LOCATION: Aerial (helicopter) application on 1,900 - 2,000 acres on Long Island of the herbicides: Accord (active ingredient glyphosate) EPA #524-326; Arsenal (active ingredient imazapyr) EPA #241-299; & the adjuvant R-11, all mixed with water to treat alder and salmonberry. Applica-

tion will begin on or about July 14, 2004, and will be completed on or about August 31, 2004, during daylight hours. No environmental impact is anticipated.
