Alaska Community Action on Toxics (ACAT) seeks committed people in Anchorage who are passionate about environmental and social justice issues to work on our voter engagement campaign. As a canvasser for ACAT you'll get an inside understanding of the fight for environmental justice. ACAT canvassers will work in our office located in Anchorage.

Our mission is to assure justice by advocating for environmental and community health. We believe that everyone has the right to clean air, clean water, and toxic-free food. This position is temporary **starting on October 15th and ending November 6th, 2018.**

Work hours will be as follows:

Training: October 15th from 4:30pm to 7:30pm

Door canvassing: October 16th to 18th from 4:30pm to 7:30pm

Door canvassing: October 20th, 27th, and Nov 3th from 10am to 2pm

Door canvassing: October 21st, 28th, and Nov 4th from 12pm to 4pm

Phone canvassing: October 22nd to November 5th from 4:30pm to 8:30pm

Phones canvassing: November 6th from 7am to 10am

Salary: Canvassers are paid \$15 per hour

Responsibilities:

- Attend a training on **Monday, October 15th from 4:30pm to 7:30pm**
- Calling/knocking on doors of Anchorage residents to encourage them to vote
- Track phone call/door knock responses in our voter files

Qualifications:

- **Must** be able to commit to working from **October 15th thru November 6th**
- Knowledge of and a passion for environmental justice and social justice issues
- Good phone manner and comfort with talking to a variety of people
- Flexibility and adaptability to change
- Ability to work well with a team, take direction and feedback, and share skills and knowledge
- Ability to bring and use your own smartphone for data entry while you door canvass
- Ability to drive and use your own vehicle for transportation to and from neighborhoods for door canvassing is preferred, but not required
