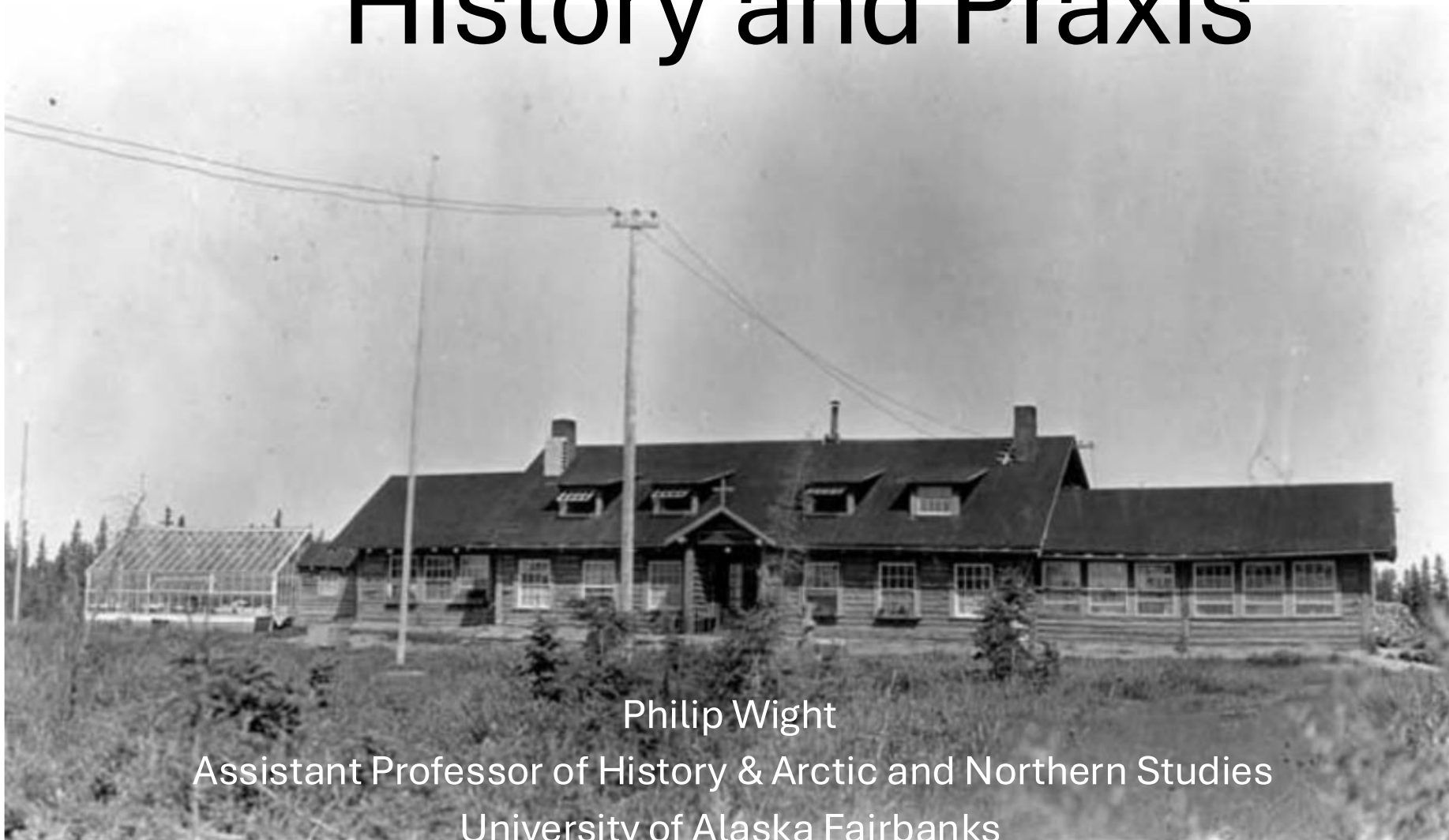

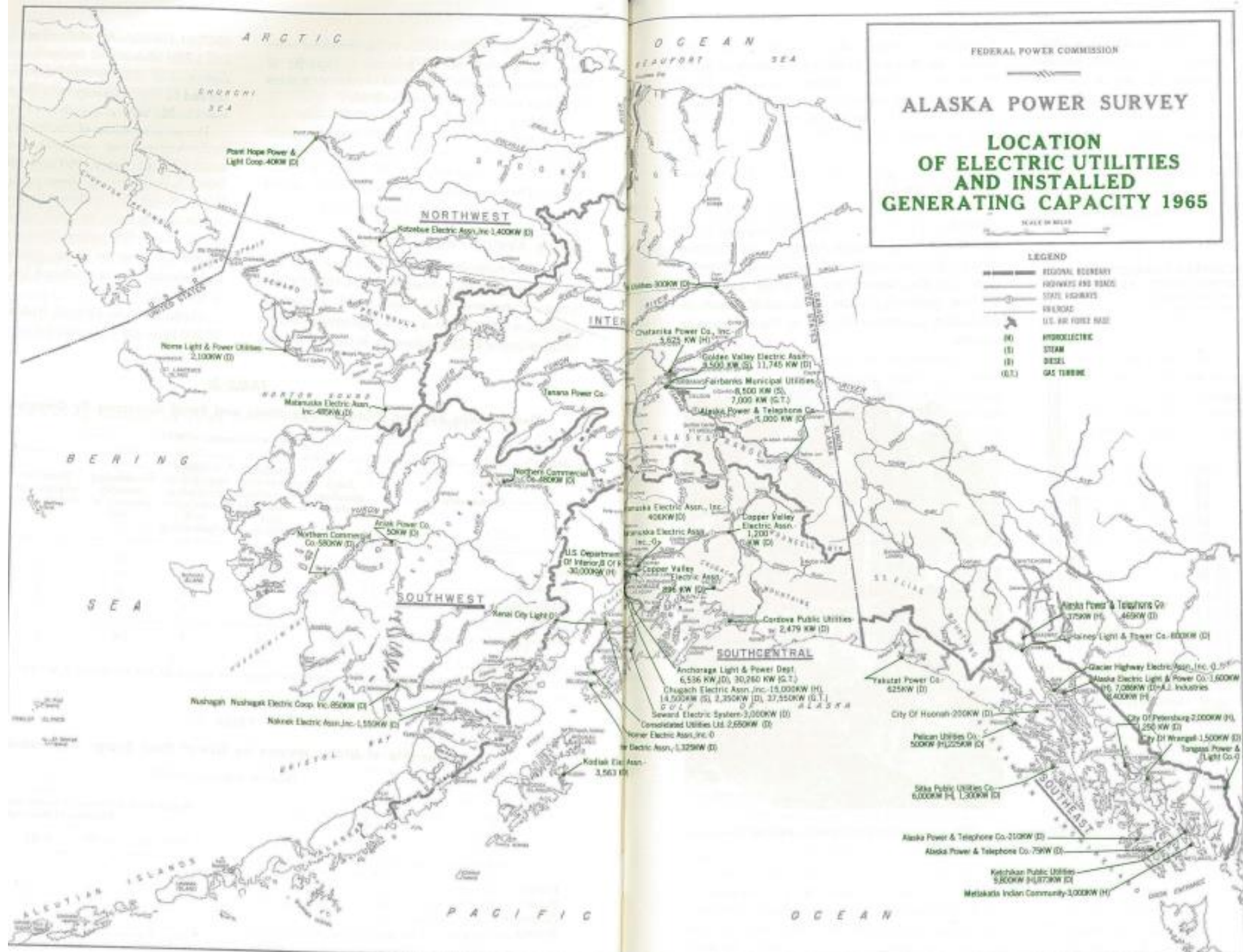

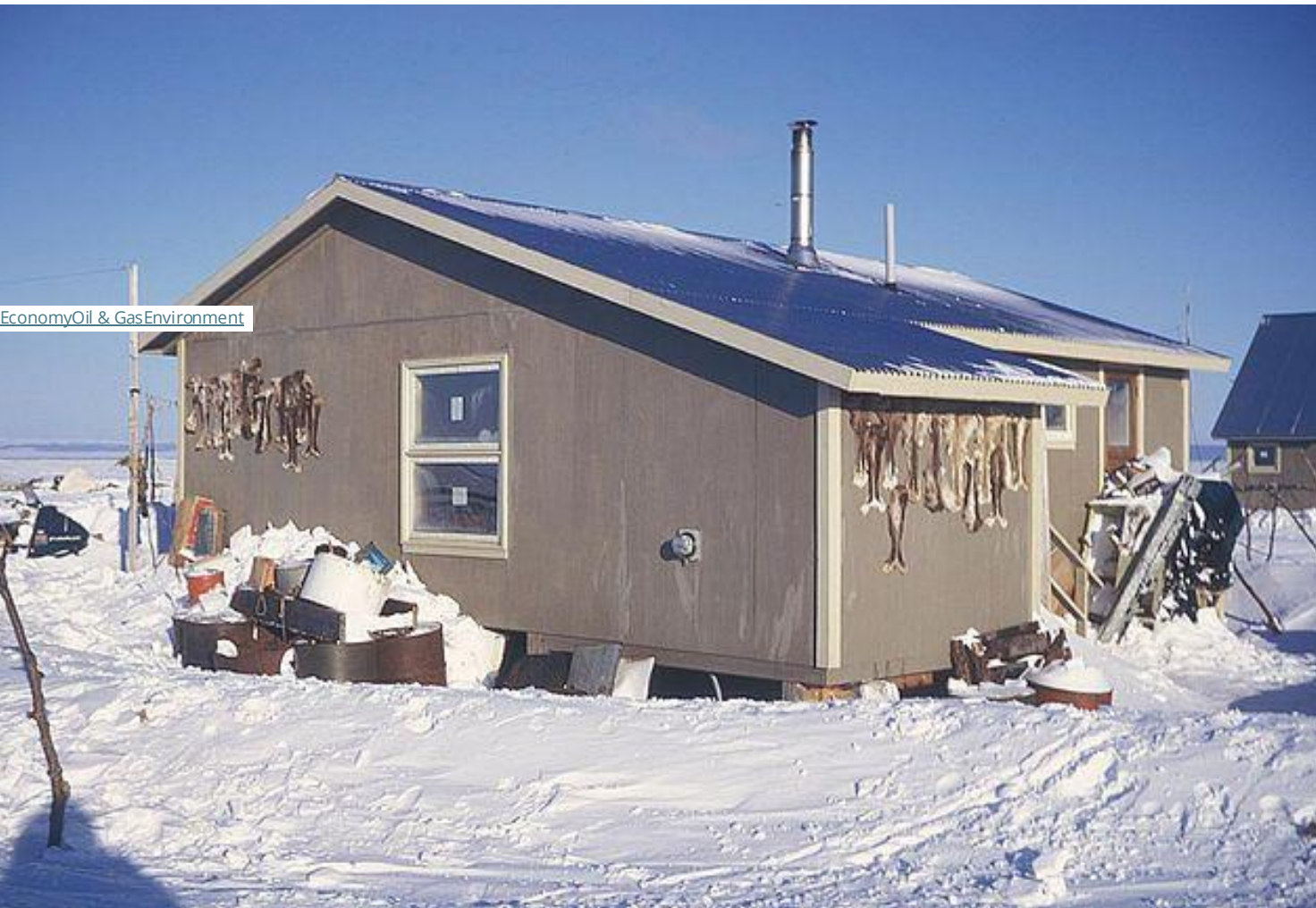


*Kwigillingok has five wind turbines, four of which are currently working. Photo: Rachel Waldholz/APRN*
